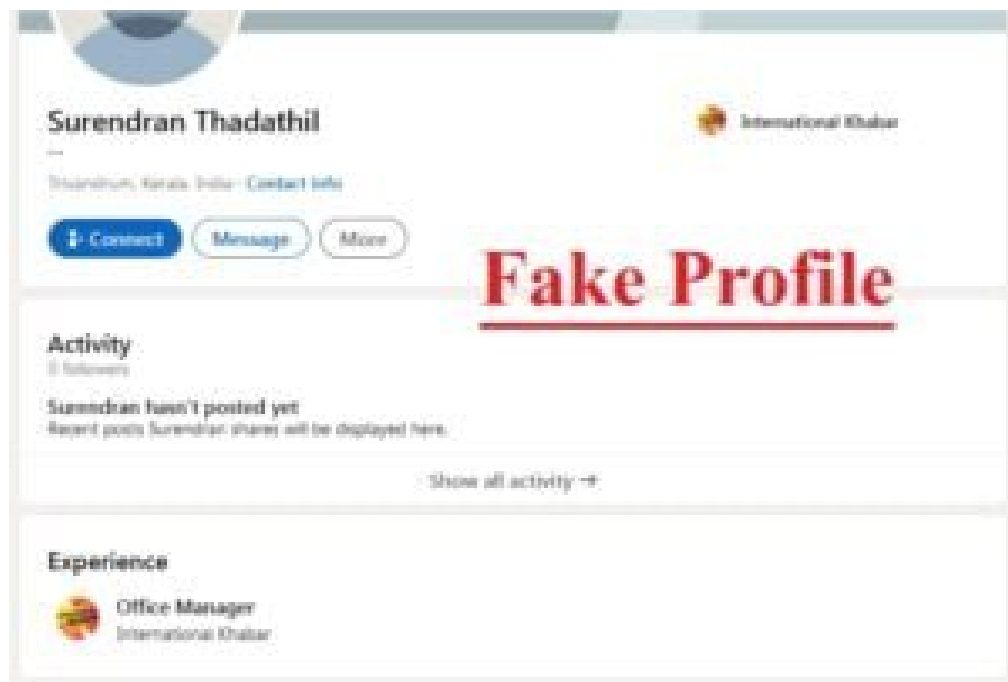
Spotting the Red Flags
