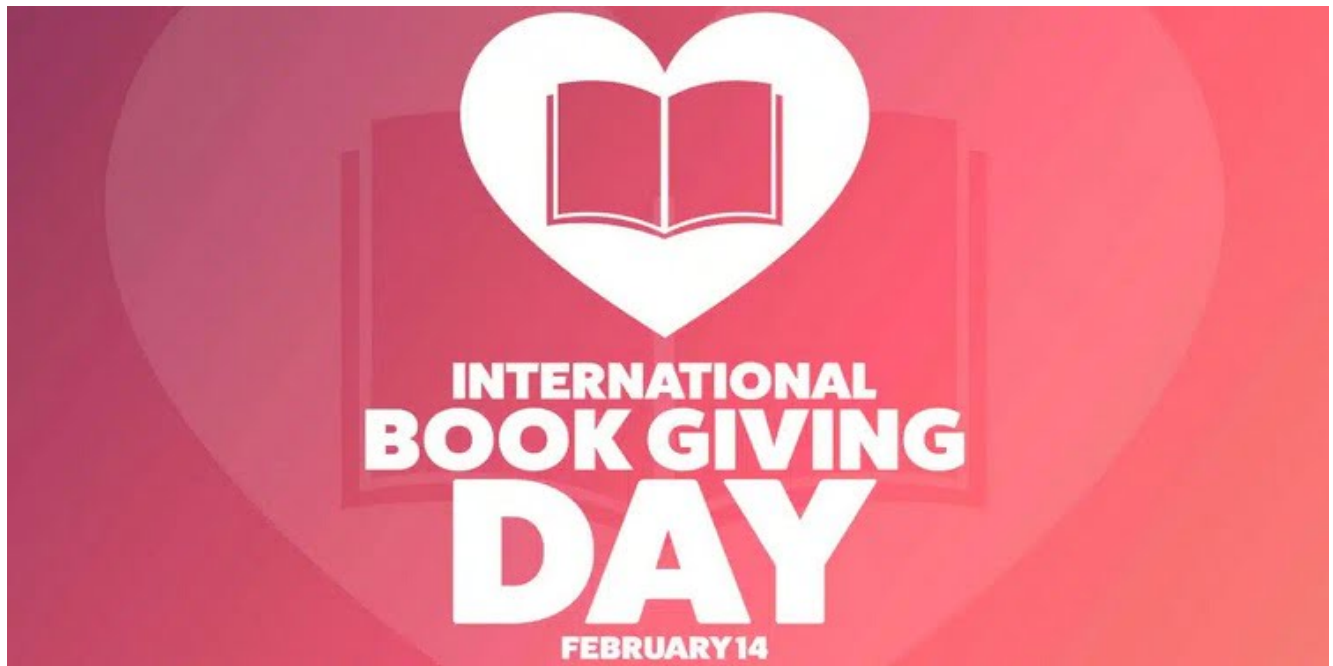


# International Book Giving Day: Spreading the Love of Books and Handwritten Notes
