

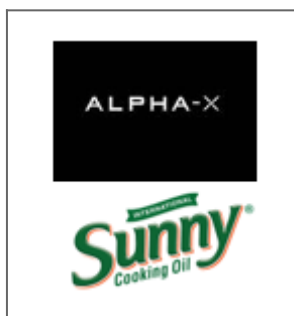
Sunny Cooking Oil Film Celebrates the Mother-child Bond and Festive Togetherness this Ganesh Chaturthi
